GREETINGS!

There is no better way to open a Newsletter than to give a very hearty "WELCOME" to our several hundred new members, representing Bungay, Halesworth, Hardwick, Hethel, Horsham, Ketteringham Hall, North Pickenham, Rackheath, Shipdham and 14th CBW, Tibenham, Wendling, and two of our fighter groups, Boxted and Debden! We are certainly glad to have you with us!

Our sincere thanks go to all who sent in names and addresses, complete rosters, and group histories - you've made it possible for us to contact hundreds of other 2AD people.

Almost exactly ten years ago - one decade - most of us were in the process of becoming civilians (GDC's) again. At that time, few of us realized that we'd lose track of our friends and buddies within a short time, and just how much our service together with such a wonderful group of people could mean to us. Eight years ago, a few brave souls, who wanted to keep alive the friendships and memories of our service together in the Second Air Division, got together and formed the Association. Membership was not solicited and there was no publicity, but a chain reaction set in by one person telling another, and within a short time we had some 800 on our roster, representing practically all of the 2AD bomber groups and two of our five fighter groups. As membership from the groups increased, we were constantly being asked "why isn't MY group contacted?" In answer to this repeated question, we have contacted six groups within the past year - 44th, 93rd, 389th, 445th, 446th, and 467th. The only rosters available were the ones in the group histories which were not complete or correct, but we are very happy to report that we've had good returns from all the groups. We hope to be able to obtain rosters for all the other groups and contact them also because it is our hope and aim to organize all the 2AD groups within the Association.

8th Annual Reunion

Since our last publication, a change in the location of the 1955 Reunion has been made. The dates remain the same - August 19-20-21, and the place will be the Hotel Sheraton Park, Washington, D. C. Complete information on the Reunion is enclosed with this Newsletter.

This will be the eighth reunion for many of our members, the second one for the 445th B.G., and the first one for five groups - Bungay, Hardwick, Hethel, Rackheath, and Shipdham. There will be a representation from all the other 2AD groups, so you can expect the biggest and best wing-ding to date.

Mrs. Edward Harrison (nee Dorothy McDonald, American Red Cross, Hardwick) writes: "My husband and I are returning to England this summer on a pleasure trip, and are calling on a few English friends living near the old base - the Morningthorpe Sargents among them. Mrs. Sargent has written me that Col. Fiegel paid them a visit a few weeks before he was killed in an air accident some time ago, and that they had a visit from Dr. Paine and his wife in 1954. She tells me also that Hardwick is derelict, with the doors of the barracks hanging askew on their hinges, the windows broken, and grass is growing in the cracks of the hardstands. I shall feel, I know, like "12 O'Clock High" when I return." We have asked Dorothy to take some pictures for us, and to give us a first hand report for a future Newsletter.

Frank Scigulinsky (44th B.G., 68th Sqdn.) returned to England in 1947 and married the girl he courted while he was stationed at Shipdham. Frank remained for a year, working on the farm of his father-in-law before returning to the States. (His brother-in-law is Robert Patterson who owned land on which Shipdham was based. 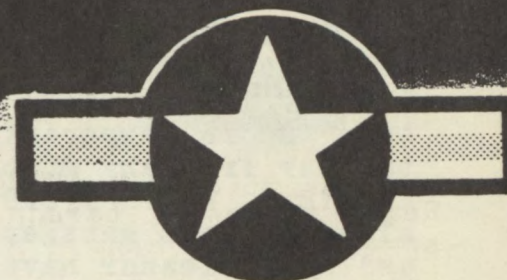
