Unit History, Detachment A. 208th Finance Section (ADO) (AVN), 392nd Bombardment Group (H), 14th Combat Wing, 2nd Air Division, AAF Station 118, APO 558, Poatmaster, New York City, New York.

Period: 14 February 1945 (Detachment activation) to 28 February 1945.

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This small unit was set up as an independent operating detachment again on 15 February 1945 in accordance with Par. 3, 80 45, Hq 2nd Air Division.

AAP 147. APO 558, 14 February 1945. The original 2974th Finance Detachment (Class 8) (Provisional) had been disbanded per Par. 1, Sec. II, 0. 0. 248, Eq. 2nd Bombardment Division, AAF 147, APO 558 (Sec Unit History of 2974th Finance Detachment for period 1 September, 1944 to 1 October 1944 for copies of orders quoted). The one officer and seven men of the unit remained on DS at AAF Station 118 and were attached to the 10th Station Complement Squadron at AAF 118 for retions, quarters and administration as directed in Par. 7, 50 208, Hq. 592nd Bombardment Group (N), AAF Station 118, APO 558, 6 Oct. 1944.

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

In accordance with Ltr., Hq. US Strategie Air Forces in Europe, subjection of Finance Personnel, dtd 15 February 1945, the MCS' of Egts. Hemrick, Stensland & Tacy were changed from 623 & 502 to 622.

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Although the unit was originally authorized one officer and 8 enlisted men, all functions have been performed efficiently with only seven salisted men. Shortly after the detachment was autivated under its present name Corporal Morris D. Glickfeld, 50056852, who handled travel pay, & assisted in the Officer's Pay Section, was transferred to U. S. Strategic Scabing Survey in Europe per Per. 5, SO 39, Hq U. K. Base Communications Zone, ETO, APO 415, 8 Feb 45. Despite the reduction in the number of enlisted personnel to six men, and therefore increasing work load on the remaining men, the service provided by this section has not diminished. No replacements are expected, except that another men may be placed on DS from a nearby finance office.



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
